Not much to say this month. When you're the only contributor to the News Letter you can run out of things to say.

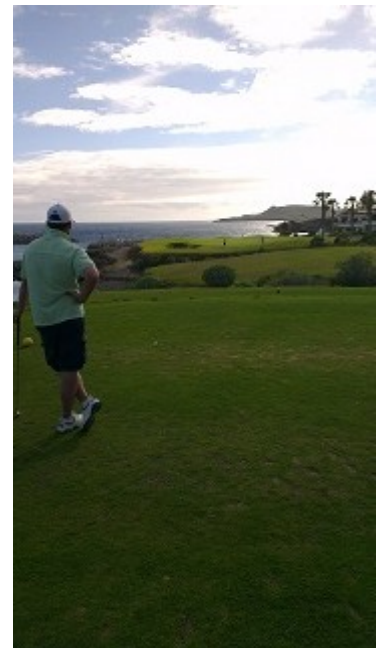
The weather took another turn for the worse so there's been little happening on the training front.
